This past year has been stellar. We exceeded fundraising and attendance goals for both our annual *Hearts With Hope* gala and *When Domestic Violence Goes to Work...* conference.

We initiated FACE TO FACE®, a life-altering program for women who have been scarred as a result of domestic violence. With partial support from the Atlanta Women's Foundation and in partnership with The American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (AAFPRS), PADV is ensuring that women receive, at no cost, the very best medical treatment for facial and dental injuries caused by domestic violence. PADV is the only organization in the nation to provide this program locally.

We also partnered with Kilgannon, a full-service advertising agency providing pro bono services to PADV's communication efforts. Kilgannon gave PADV a fresh corporate image, redesigned our logo and collateral, produced a new educational video, and plans to redesign our Web site and create a new ad campaign.

In this report, you will read the stories of two domestic violence survivors. With the help of PADV, they have transformed their lives. Their achievements are a true reflection of their courage.

I spent the first ten years of my life with my mom living in a little white house on Paris Street in Tampa, Florida. My mother and I lived an idyllic life. Before my 11th birthday, our peaceful world changed dramatically. My mother met Frank, a deacon in our church. They married about six months after they met. Soon after, he began his campaign to isolate us. Frank convinced my mother to quit college.

The physical abuse started three months into their marriage. We were getting ready for church and my mother was running late. With hard plastic rollers still in her hair, Frank beat her until the rollers pierced her scalp and cracked her skull. To this day, I cannot put into words what it was like to see my mother, blood streaming down her face, telling me everything would be all right. I knew that nothing would ever be right as long as Frank was in our lives.

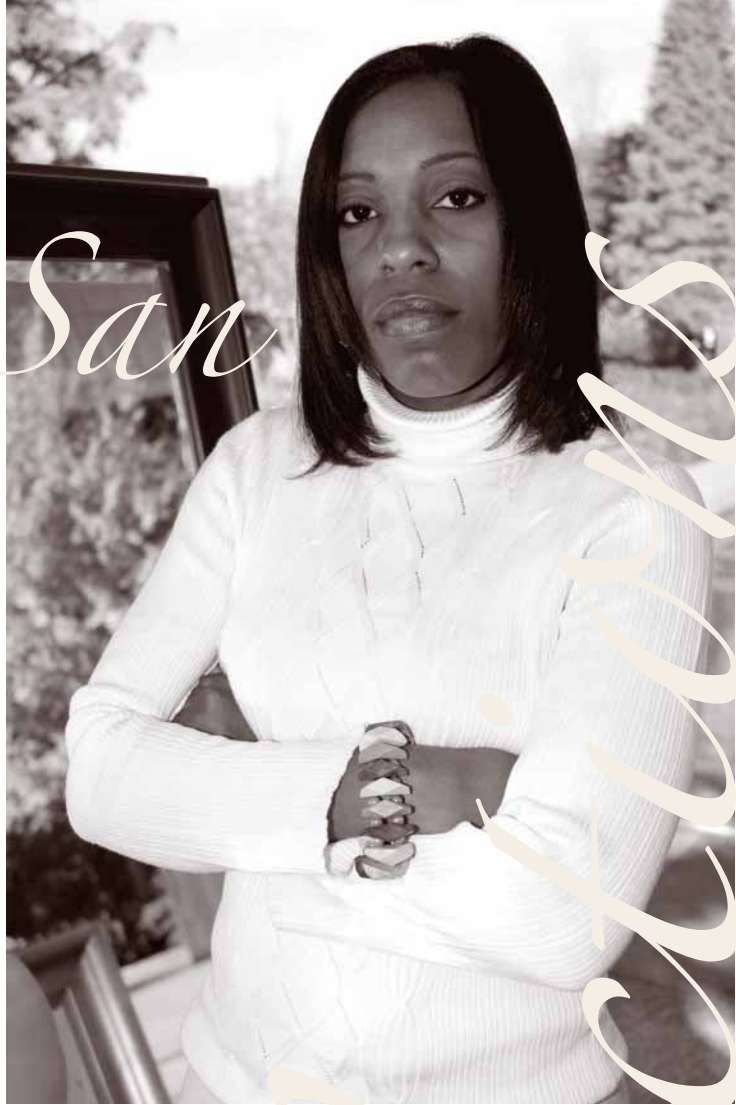
Then one day, without any notice, Frank came home and said we had to move out of state. There was no discussion. If we didn't go, he'd kill us. So we packed what little we could fit into a Pontiac Bonneville and drove to Atlanta.

We moved two more times before our final and successful attempt to escape. We spent my 15th birthday in a homeless shelter, as well as Christmas and New Year's. Four months later, we moved into our own home. We got our lives back, and three years later, when I was preparing to graduate from high school, my mother was preparing to graduate from college.

My mother went on to a successful career in pharmaceuticals. She married a wonderful man, her best friend, in 1997. She passed away in March of this year with us beside her after a six-year battle with cancer.

In honor of her and as homage to my childhood experience living with domestic violence, I've partnered with PADV to share some of the proceeds from my new line of heirloom quality handcrafted greeting cards and socials — PeaceWorks.

I met my abuser when I was 19 years old. We had the typical romantic courtship like most. At first he treated me like a queen, then six months into the relationship the abuse began. Embarrassed by the injuries and black eyes, I would hide the abuse with baggy clothes and excessive makeup.

When I was eight months pregnant with our son, my abuser asked me to help him rake our lawn. When I voiced that I didn't feel up to it, he hit me in the face with the rake.

I have been beaten, robbed of my money and isolated from my friends and family. I had to tell him where I was going and why. On one occasion, I visited my grandmother for lunch, and I didn't tell him. He drove by and saw my car and called me outside. He punched me in the mouth and burst my lip. I called the police. An officer came and spoke to me while my mouth was bleeding, but he was not arrested.

I called the police on several occasions, and never once was he arrested for beating me. Finally the police got tired of me calling and threatened to arrest us both if they had to come back. At this point I felt that I had no options and had no other recourse.

But then I contacted PADV. They helped me when no else would. They gave me the resources I needed to help keep me and my children safe. They invited me and my children to attend a support group and offered us a place to stay. My children and I have been safe and free from his abuse for four years. Thank you, PADV, for all your help and support.

## *Volunteers Who Keep Giving*

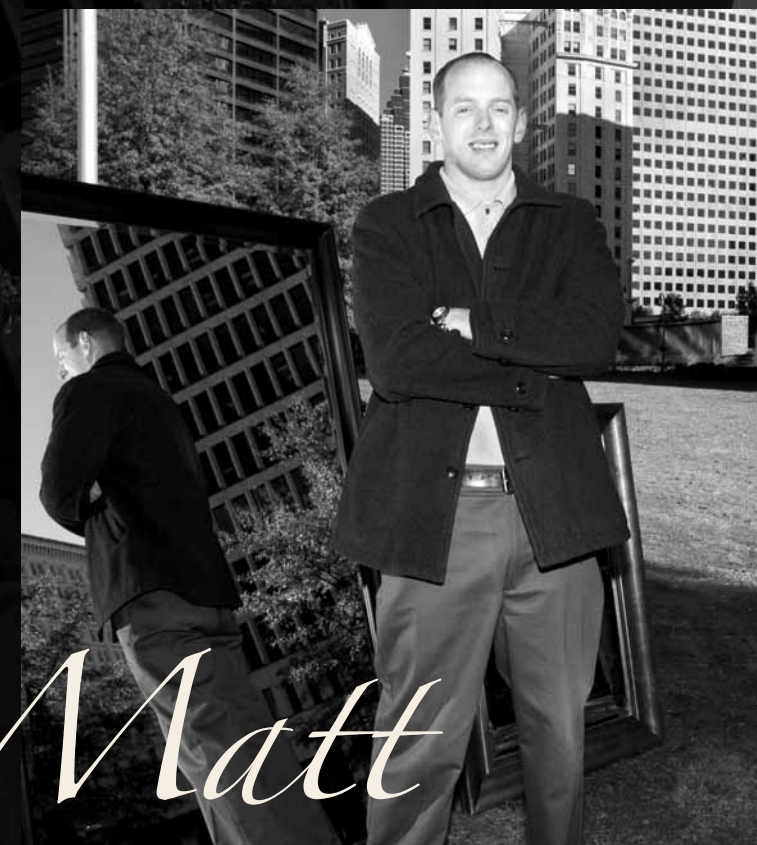
I attend college full time and work 40 hours a week. That makes finding time to volunteer difficult. Still, I have a strong need to give back to my community. In doing my internet search, PADV's Web site immediately grabbed my attention and my search was over. I began volunteering in September 2004, and since then I've been motivated and inspired by the women and their children who seek safety at our shelters.

My volunteer experiences vary, but the ones I enjoy the most are working with the children. They always seem excited and happy to see me. They greet me at the door with their bright smiles and exuberant questions, "What do you have to do today, Matt," followed by, "Can we help?"

My commitment to ending domestic violence continues to grow stronger with each new experience at PADV. I encourage anyone who wants to make a difference to give their time and money, and join PADV in supporting women and their children in their efforts to live violence free.

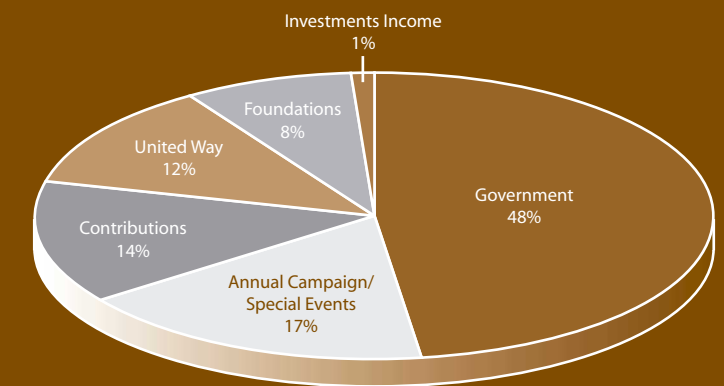

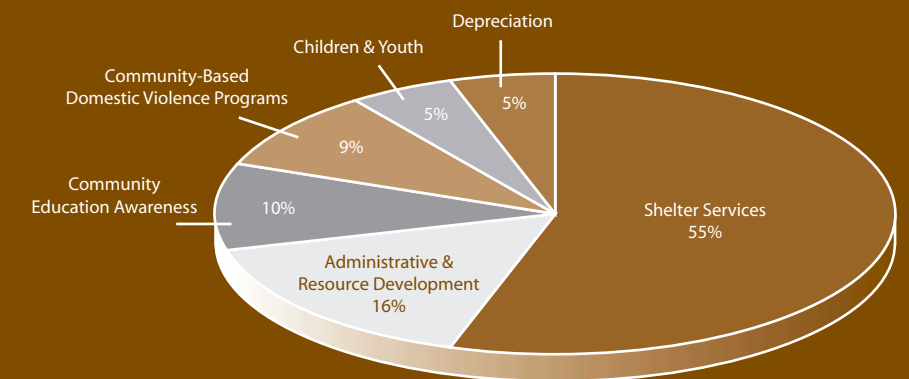
## Financial Overview of FY 2005
