Position Description:

Provide assistance with Teen Dating Violence Prevention Program (hereafter TDVPP) and special teen events.

Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Provide Teen Dating Violence prevention education to youth serving organizations.
2. Assist in the preparation and co-facilitation of curriculum and tabling events.
3. Promote TDVPP and assist with event scheduling.
4. Manage TDVPP social media.
5. Assist in the coordination of Teens Against Dating Violence (hereafter TADV) Advisory Board recruitment and activities.
6. Record accurate statistical information in database.
7. Foster and maintain excellent, professional working relations with staff and volunteers and functions as part of a team.
8. Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Ability to work well with teens.
- Flexible and energetic.
- Works well independently and under supervision.
- Ability to work with culturally diverse groups.
- Must work flexible schedule, including some evenings and weekends.
- Knowledge of dating violence and teen development preferred.

Placement Requirements:

1. Attend PADV's Advocate Training.
2. Shadow one TDV101 presentation.
3. Commit to service for a minimum of one semester
4. Pass criminal background check.
